

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-2021-A021  
CANCELLING THE ANNUAL TOWN MEETING FOR THE FISCAL YEAR  
BEGINNING MARCH 31, 2019 AND ENDING APRIL 1, 2020  
(said Annual Town Meeting scheduled for April 14, 2020)  
AFTON TOWNSHIP, DEKALB COUNTY, ILLINOIS

**WHEREAS**, according to 60 ILCS 1/30-5, the annual town meeting shall be held on the second Tuesday of April each year., and

**WHEREAS**, according to HB 2096 (Public Act 101-0632) the annual town meeting was cancelled in April via Executive Order (Proclamation Filed April 1, 2020 in the Office of the Secretary of State by Governor J.B. Pritzker).

**WHEREAS**, said Proclamation, Section 1. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 7 of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act, 20 ILCS 3305/7, Governor J.B. Pritzker finds that a continuing disaster exists within the State of Illinois and specifically declare all counties in the State of Illinois as a disaster area. And

**WHEREAS**, this proclamation continues the Governor's authority to exercise all of the emergency powers provided in Section 7 of the Illinois Emergency Management Agency Act, 20, ILCS 3305/7, thereby eliminating the ability of Afton Township to schedule the April 14, 2020 Annual Town Meeting, and


**WHEREAS**, there is no clear resolution from the State of Illinois legislature to determine when Governor J.B. Pritzker's declaration of a state of emergency has ended, and

**WHEREAS**, the onerous requirements to hold a public meeting place Afton Township in the untenable position of being unable to hold said public meeting.

**THEREFORE**, be it known, that the Afton Township Board has determined no annual meeting will be held in 2020.
